LICENSEE FIREWOOD PERMIT POLICY

- 1. All Connecticut Lakes Timber Company, LLC Licensees must have a permit to cut firewood on Connecticut Lakes Timber Company, LLC lands.
- 2. No wood is to be removed from active log landings or harvesting operations. Active is defined as having equipment on site (whether operators are there or not) and/or logs or pulpwood is stacked for hauling.
- 3. The maximum number of cords that may be removed under a permit will be three (3). Only one permit will be issued per Licensee. Wood is for personal use only, not for sale or resale to others.
- 4. Firewood must be cut only from logging residues and dead and down trees.
- 5. A permit must be in possession and presented upon request from Connecticut Lakes Timber Company, LLC personnel or any enforcement entity.
- 6. The Licensee must agree to the indemnification and liability clause set forth in the permit.
- 7. Connecticut Lakes Timber Company, LLC timberlands will be patrolled for compliance with this policy.
- 8. No loading equipment (skidders, tractors, skip jacks, etc.) is permitted.
- 9. No tops or slash shall be left in roads or ditches.
- 10. No firewood shall be cut by anyone other than the permit holder unless approved by a Connecticut Lakes Timber Company, LLC representative
