Re: Sunday Hunting in Virginia

This memo serves as written permission for you and the members of your hunt club, as listed in the Hunting License Agreement with the Heartwood Forestland Fund IV, L.P. and Heartwood Forestland Fund V, L.P. to hunt on Sundays as allowed by Virginia and local county hunting laws and regulations. This permission does not change or modify any of the terms of the signed Hunting License Agreement. All pertinent laws and regulations still apply to the club's hunting activities. The following excerpt is from the Virginia Department of Game & Inland Fisheries website: (emphasis added)

“On March 5, 2014, Governor Terry McAuliffe signed into law Hunting on Sundays. The new law allows hunting on Sundays under certain circumstances. A person may hunt waterfowl, subject to restrictions imposed by the Director of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, and a landowner and his immediate family or **a person with written permission from the landowner may hunt or kill any wild bird or wild animal, including nuisance species, on the landowner's property. However, the aforementioned hunting activities cannot occur within 200 yards of a house of worship and prohibits the hunting of deer or bear with a gun, firearm, or other weapon with the aid or assistance of dogs on Sunday.**”

Copies of this memo can be made available by printing this letter for each club member to carry while hunting on the property on Sundays, as specified by the Virginia law.
